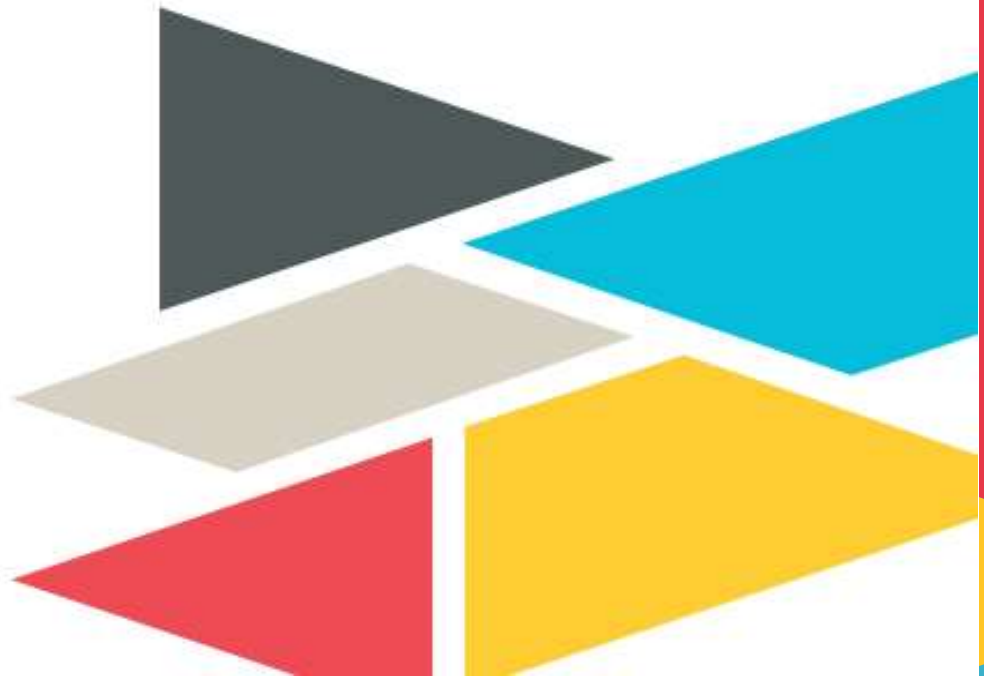

What is Similarity Check?

A service powered by the iThenticate technology that is offered by Crossref to its qualifying members.

1. Software that analyses and compares text
2. Database of content to check text against

Over 1100 users

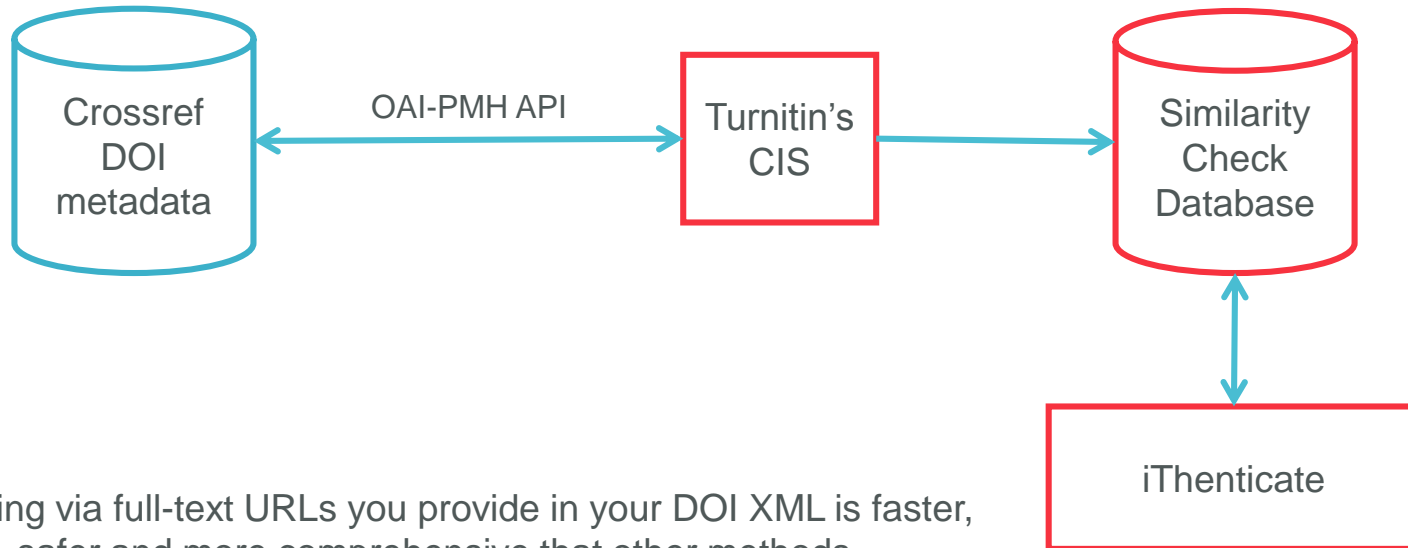
52 million full-text content items indexed

3. Indexing upgrade



Indexing via full-text URLs you provide in your DOI XML is faster, safer and more comprehensive than other methods.

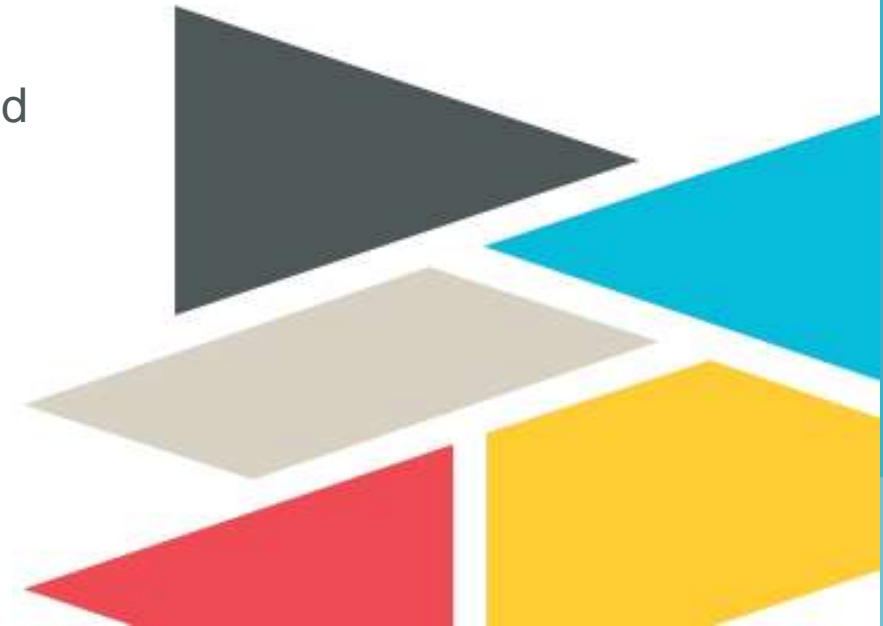
Key benefits of a single method

Reduced traffic to publisher servers

Reduced margin for error and simplified issue recovery

Quicker turnaround on indexing with fewer delays

Daily ingest, better than monthly!
